### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Rick Baldwin reviewed Proposals 1 and 2 to adjust the attendance zone boundaries of Linda Rankin Givens

Elementary School, D'Vorre and Hal Ober Elementary School, and Clarence Piggott Elementary School. Rick Baldwin called for public input.

Several parents of Givens Elementary School students spoke in favor of Proposal 2 or no change. Although not under the purview of AZAC, most spoke against going year round.

Two parents of Bonner Elementary School students spoke of accountability of bond spending, the cost of year round calendars and the need for long term solutions to overcrowding, which they do not consider rezoning.

One grandparent spoke to the need for all to come together with government and developers to campaign for building more schools.

A few Staton Elementary School parents spoke against both proposals and the year round calendar.

One Staton Elementary School parent suggested looking to zone these students to Goolsby Elementary School rather than either proposal.

One Givens parent suggested looking to zone these students to Lummis Elementary School or Givens Elementary School.

Several parents from each school addressed a lack of trust on the part of the community with CCSD's handling of finances.

A few parents spoke to the need for developers being required to contribute to the building of schools through impact fees.

### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Rick Baldwin reviewed the proposal to adjust the attendance zone boundaries of Walter Johnson Junior High School and Sig Rogich Middle School.

Rick Baldwin called for public input.

One grandparent spoke to the need for all to come together with government and developers to campaign for building more schools.

One parent from Givens Elementary School spoke in favor of Proposal 2.

Zoning recommendations will be voted upon by the Board of School Trustees at the regular board meeting on February 26, 2015, at 4:00 p.m.
