## **MAGNET SCHOOLS AND CAREER AND TECHNICAL ACADEMIES.**

Discussion on the Magnet Schools and Career and Technical Academies in the Clark County School District.

Ms. Moore gave an overview of the Magnet Schools, Career and Technical Academies, and Select Schools process and what they offer. The presentation was followed by a question and answer period.

Superintendent Skorkowsky requested input of programs that they would like implement in the Magnet, Career and Technical Academy, and Select Schools program.

Committee members discussed the different programs that they would like to see implemented.

## **SCHOOL SAFETY.**

Discussion on the current school safety practices in the Clark County School District.

Superintendent Skorkowsky asked committee members for feedback on safety in Clark County School District schools.

Committee members discussed what they thought was safe and unsafe and how they could increase school safety altogether. Members suggested things such as metal detectors, educational safety training, color coded lanyards and stickers, scanners, doorbells, metro shift classes, teacher training, hard lockdowns, evacuations, and self-defense course in P.E.

Superintendent Skorkowsky also discussed steps that are being taken as far as safety, and the challenges that the school district faces.

Committee members and Superintendent Skorkowsky also discussed information about the process for a threat on a school, how many police are assigned to a school, safe voice, and school walkouts.
