The Open Book tools provide transparency and accountability for the District's budgeted appropriations and FTE staff positions by department and major functional area. Free Reduced Lunch Application and Information Available Online

Many new and returning students may be eligible for <u>free and reduced-price meals</u> through the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), School Breakfast Program (SBP), Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), and the After School Care Snack Program (ASCSP), available in Clark County School District schools.

Applications and instructions on how to apply are provided at <u>www.myschoolapps.com</u>. Paper applications are available in all school cafeterias. Families must fill out an application online, or turn in a paper application at the school. Only one application is needed per household.

Eligibility for free and reduced-price meals from the previous year will continue for up to 30 operating days into the 2017-2018 school year. Families whose household incomes are less than or equal to the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines (IEGs) are eligible for free and reduced-price meals. Students can get Homework help from Library District's Website

The Las Vegas-Clark County Library District's website, <u>lvccld.org</u>, offers homework help to local K-12 students. The website also offers HelpNow, which connects students with a live tutor to help with subjects including mathematics, science and English.

North Las Vegas obtains Grant to continue Pedestrian Safety Program

Thanks to a \$108,000 state grant, 15 CCSD elementary schools will continue to participate in the "Stop, Look and Listen" pedestrian awareness program. As reported by the <u>Las Vegas Review-Journal</u>, the program is administered by the North Las Vegas Police Department.

FACES helps Parents Navigate the District

FACES (Family and Community Engagement Services) will host its first Family Learning Resource Academy (FLRA) of the school year at the East Las Vegas Community Center, 250 N. Eastern Ave., Las Vegas, from 9 a.m. – noon.

The session will provide information on supports and resources that school district department's offer while gaining strategies in how to best support their children on their road to academic achievement.

Families will have the opportunity to speak with 15 CCSD departments, including Food Service and Transportation, on how the department supports CCSD students. Parents will also learn how to best communicate with their child's school, as many have inquired about joining their School Organizational Team (SOT).

With the SOT elections happening throughout September, the initial FLRA will be a great way for parents to dive into the world of SOTs to be involved in their child's school action plan and how it could affect their child's academic success.

The session will feature free childcare for preschool-aged children that include developmentally appropriate activities. It will also be presented in Spanish, with light refreshments available.

Three more FLRAs are scheduled later in the school year that will focus on academic topics:

- Tuesday, November 14, 2017 at Springs Preserve – the FLRA will focus on science, technology, engineering and math-related topics.
- Wednesday, February 7, 2018 at Whitney Recreation Center the FLRA will focus on reading and English language arts.
- Thursday, April 12, 2018 Desert Breeze Community Center – the FLRA will focus on math.

First grade students at Tanaka Elementary School will learn Spanish words from their teachers and from Spanish-speaking students.


Sierra High School students will learn the tango and flamenco dances, and also enjoy a variety of foods ranging from pupusas to empanadas.
