## SCHOOL BOARD STUDENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Board of School Trustees has established the School Board Student Advisory Committee (SB SAC) to obtain opinions from high school students with respect to a variety of issues and topics pertaining to the Clark County School District.

I. The Superintendent or designee shall designate an individual who will serve as the Facilitator of the SB SAC.

## II. Membership

- A. Membership shall be open to high school students in Grades 9, 10, 11, or 12.
- B. Applications shall be submitted to the Office of the Board of School Trustees by a date established by the SB SAC Board Liaison in coordination with the Facilitator.
- C. Each Trustee will appoint members within his or her district.
- D. SB SAC members will be sworn in at a meeting of the Board of School Trustees.

## III. Meetings

- A. The SB SAC will be subject to the State of Nevada Open Meeting Law.
- B. Meetings will be conducted according to Robert's Rules of Order for Small Boards.
- C. The SB SAC will hold regular meetings throughout the school year, in addition to special meetings, as required, to conduct its business at dates and times established by the Facilitator.
- D. The SB SAC will meet at locations designated by the Facilitator.
- E. The SB SAC will meet with representative members of the Board of School Trustees and/or Clark County School District officials at least once in the fall and once in the spring.
