### CONSTRUCTION BIDS

- I. The Board of School Trustees designates the Chief of Facilities, as its authorized representative for construction change orders not to cumulatively exceed three percent of the original contract for new construction and change in services not to cumulatively exceed five percent of the original contract for additions, rehabilitation, remodeling, renovation, and modernization; the maintenance, and/or repair of facilities, grounds, pavements, utilities, to include easements, leases, and other public works.
- II. The Chief of Facilities, may further designate/delegate authorized representatives as required.
- III. Advertising, bidding, award, and administration of public works contracts shall be in compliance with Nevada Statutes and district policies and procedures.
- IV. Only those contractors that have proven their qualifications as a responsible contractor and responsive to district requirements shall be allowed to bid district public works.
- V. The Board of School Trustees may exercise the right to reject any and/or all public works bids as necessary to ensure the best interests of the public.
