The Weekly Legislative Update for the Clark County School District

It's a wrap! As promised, we have finalized our summary report of the session and bills enacted by the Legislature. The report is posted on our website, <http://ccsd.net/departments/government-affairs/government-affairs-legislation>.

We've expanded this year's report to include a synopsis of the education budget, a list of top 10 bills (determined by those bills that require the most intense efforts to implement), our bi-annual impact report, bill summaries, and a compilation of all the legislative updates sent throughout the session.
